I would also like to take this opportunity to wish all the children across the school all the very best as they will be taking part in a number of DfE Statutory Assessments:

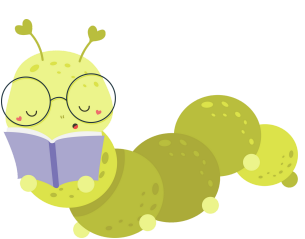
- Year 1 & 2 Phonics Screening Check
